


Richard Ford

RICHARD FORD, hailed as the “Babe Ruth of novelists” by the *Washington Post Book World*, is the author of three

collections of short fiction and six novels, including *Independence Day*, the first to win both the Pulitzer Prize and the PEN/Faulkner Award. 
